



MD-MPH Dual Degree

Medical students at UTMB can earn the **Master of Public Health (MPH) degree** through a five-year dual degree program. Two concentrations are available: Epidemiology and Biostatistics.

MPH training provides the knowledge, skills, and values needed to succeed in careers that bridge medicine and public health. Graduates of the program will be prepared to **practice evidence-based and community-oriented public health** in a range of clinical, occupational, and community settings.

The MPH year is typically scheduled between years 3 and 4 of medical school. USMLE Step II exams must be completed before graduate enrollment begins.

To apply: students must complete the Graduate School of Biomedical Sciences application, provide 3 letters of reference, write a personal statement addressing interest in public health, and pay the application fee. The online application process can be accessed at: www.utmb.edu/onlineapp.

The MPH degree is fully accredited by the Council on Education for Public Health.
