



The **Public Health Track** provides medical students interested in public health careers with focused training in public health research and practice skills.

Requirements are integrated into the the four-year UTMB Health SOM curriculum and involve coursework, clinical and/or research electives, as well as independent study and completion of a scholarly project based on a public health experience.

Successfull completion of the track requirements will merit designation as *Scholar in Public Health*, which is noted on the SOM transcript and at the commencement ceremony.

All students enrolled in the School of Medicine are eligible to enroll. Students can have dual enrollment in other SOM tracks.
